- c) Clear original black and white or colour pictures will only be reviewed. No photo-shopped or edited pictures will be considered.*
- d) All pictures must be submitted with a very brief description of the contents.*

Pictures can be submitted by e-mail to the undersigned individuals below. Kindly note that by submitting pictures, members forfeit all copyright pertaining to the publication of selected pictures by TAC. Should any member have old pictures and need assistance to get them scanned or otherwise, kindly contact the undersigned and we will assist accordingly.

The cut-off date for the submission of pictures is the **29th of June 2016**, so please take the time to reflect and "dig" out that one picture from a project(s) that remains in your memory.
