Presentation Overview

Construction of the long-awaited Scarborough Subway Extension is underway. The Scarborough Subway Extension will bring approximately 7.8 kilometres of much-needed subway service to Scarborough, making it faster and easier for approximately 105,000 riders to get where they need to be each day. TTC's Line 2 will be extended, creating three new subway stations at Lawrence Avenue and McCowan Road, Progress Avenue and McCowan Road and Sheppard Avenue and McCowan Road.

This extension will also create interchange options to connect transit services for the Stouffville GO Line and the future Eglinton Crosstown LRT at Kennedy station. The future Durham-Scarborough Bus Rapid Transit will also have connections from the new subway station at Progress Avenue and McCowan Road. Our targeted in-service date is 2029-2030.
